UNO's Glacier Creek Preserve Summer 2025 Internship







Internship Description:

- Glacier Creek Preserve is looking for **two Preserve Steward Interns** for Summer 2025. The Internship, which involves physical labor in outdoor field conditions, will assist in activities located primarily at **Glacier Creek Preserve** and **T. L. Davis Preserve**.
- Oversight of the Internship Program is the responsibility of the Preserves Director with on-site supervision provided by the Land Management Specialist or Preserve Operations Administrator.
- Interns are expected to work a minimum of 125 hours from May through August with a minimum of 12 hours per week. A specific schedule will be arranged with Preserve Staff.
- A \$1875.00 stipend will be paid on completion of the internship.

Activities may include: 1) Mechanical and chemical invasive species control, 2) Native prairie seed collection, 3) Tree and brush cutting and clearing, 4) Assisting with prescribed burns, 5) GPS and environmental data collection, 6) Assisting with research and monitoring projects, 7) General repair and maintenance of existing structures and equipment, 8) Grounds maintenance, and 9) Assisting with volunteer workdays and other activities that may occur during the internship.

Qualifications:

- Applicants must be current college-level students or recent college-level graduates and must be at least 18 years old.
- Applicants must be in good physical condition and willing to work outdoors.
- Applicants must be able or willing to learn to use hand tools, including loppers, hand saws, weed eaters, and backpack sprayers.
- Applicants must be able or willing to learn to use a tractor, UTV, 4 x 4 Ford F-250 truck, and various mowers and brush cutters.
- Applicants with prior land management experience are preferred.
- Applicants must be able to use equipment safely and independently after training.
- Applicants selected must sign waivers of liability before beginning the internship.
