




Age Total 2010 2017


Percentage of Nebraskans Age 65 and Older Living in Households Who Are Living Alone by Sex




Aging and Disability Are Not Synonymous

Rural Counties Have the Highest Percentages of Persons 65+ in Poverty


Percent of Population in Poverty by County Groups
