## **CONDUCT GUIDELINES**

## NEBRASKA SCIENCE OLYMPIAD STATE TOURNAMENT

The Nebraska Science Olympiad Committee requires each team attending the Nebraska Science Olympiad State
Tournament to complete this form. You may turn it in on April 26, 2025, during Check-in. But to be safe, I suggest that

- 1. The term "delegate" shall mean any Science Olympiad delegate, student, observer, or guest participating in an activity.
- 2. Appropriate attire will be expected. Matching team shirts or matching shirts with your school logo are recommended. Jeans are permissible if they are clean and not cut off, frayed, or full of holes.
- 3. There shall be no defacing of property. Any damage to any property or furnishing in meeting rooms or conference locations must be paid by the individual or team responsible and may subject the individual to criminal prosecution.
- 4. Delegates shall keep their Science Olympiad coach/sponsors informed of their activities and whereabouts at all times.
- 5. Delegates are not allowed to leave the premises of the University of Nebraska-Lincoln campus at any time during the day of the competition. The only exception to this would be for lunch break, and students must be accompanied by their coach or an adult supervisor during this time period.
- 6. Delegates shall be prompt and prepared for all activities.
- 7. No alcoholic beverages or narcotics in any form shall be possessed by individuals at any time, under any circumstances while representing their local school and Science Olympiad team. Use or possession of such substances may subject the individual to criminal prosecution.
- 8. No use of tobacco products in public will be permitted while a delegate is representing his/her local school and Science Olympiad team.
- 9. Delegates are required to attend all sessions and activities assigned, opening and closing ceremonies, guest speaker events, and all competitive events for which they are registered.
- 10. <u>Identification badges/name tags will be worn at all times</u> while participating in the Nebraska Science Olympiad state tournament, meeting, or activity. (These will be in your welcome packet.)
- 11. Conduct not conducive to an educational competition will not be allowed. Such conduct includes actions disrupting a businesslike atmosphere, association with non-Science Olympiad delegates, or activities which endanger self/others.
