Submit Animal Exposure Health Surveillance Questionnaire

- 1. RSS→EHS tab→ Med Questionnaire→UNO
- 2. Category 1 is for entrance into the animal facility, field work, and contact with rodents, fish, dogs, and cats.
- 3. Category 2 is for contact with nonhuman primates. DO NOT COMPLETE THIS QUESTIONNAIRE IF YOU WILL NOT BE WORKING WITH NHPs.

Complete Occupational Health and Safety Training

- 1. Email <u>iacuc@unomaha.edu</u> for enrollment in the course, and include the following information:
 - a. Species you will be working with
 - b. PI/Faculty you are working with
 - c. If you are providing husbandry and/or will be doing research
- 2. Once you receive the enrollment link, log in to Bridge and complete training with grade of 80% or above

Complete CITI IACUC Basics training

- 1. Go to <u>www.citiprogram.org.</u> Register and create profile.
- 2. Complete the "Investigators, Staff, and Students" IACUC course.

Complete your profile in RSS

- 1. Log in to <u>RSS</u>
- 2. Click UNO IACUC \rightarrow UNO Qualifications
- 3. Enter your personal information, education (click the notepad icon), current skills, and a description of how you acquired your current skills or related work experience.
